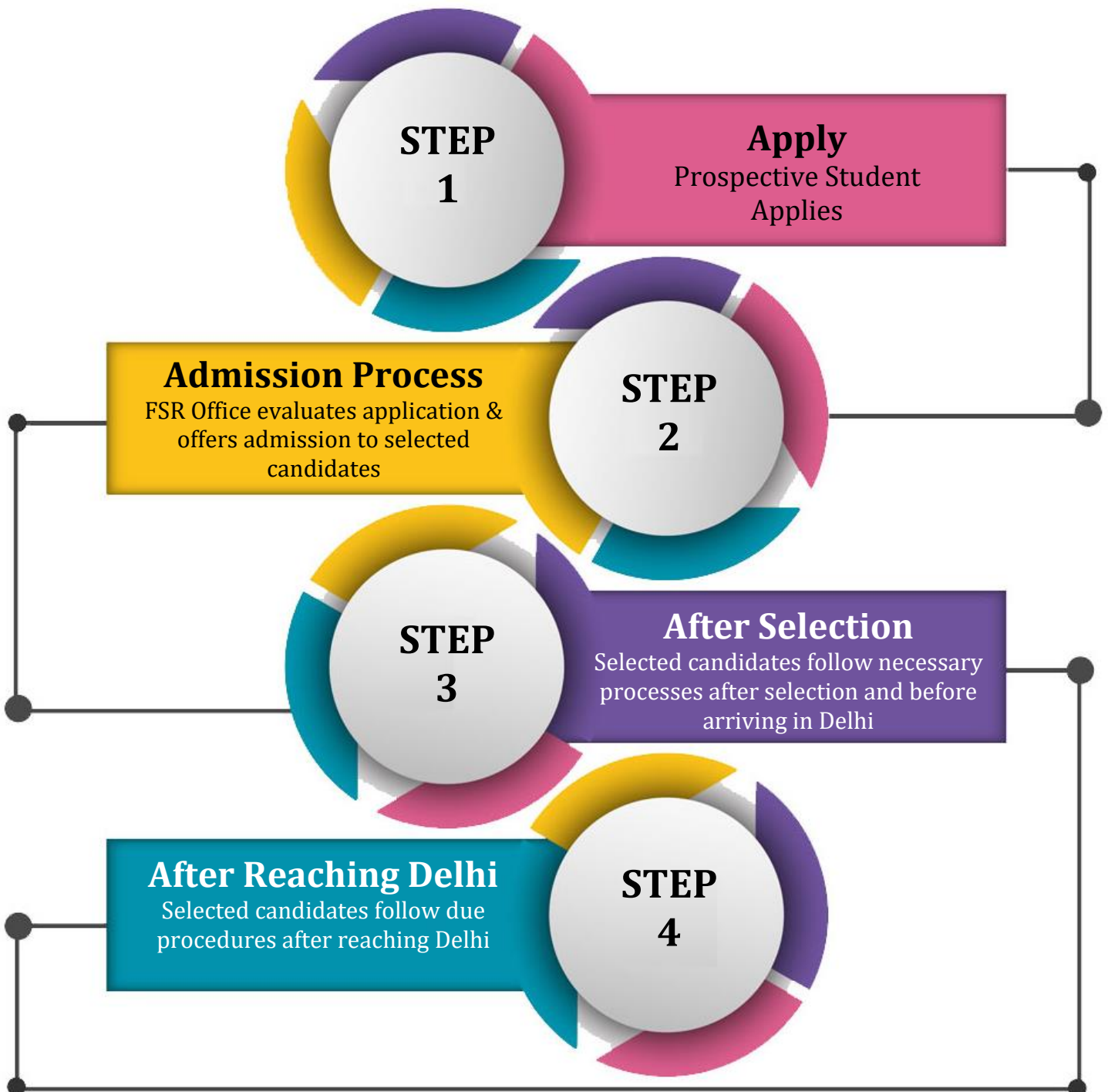


ADMISSION PROCEDURE FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS FOR THE ACADEMIC SESSION 2020-2021



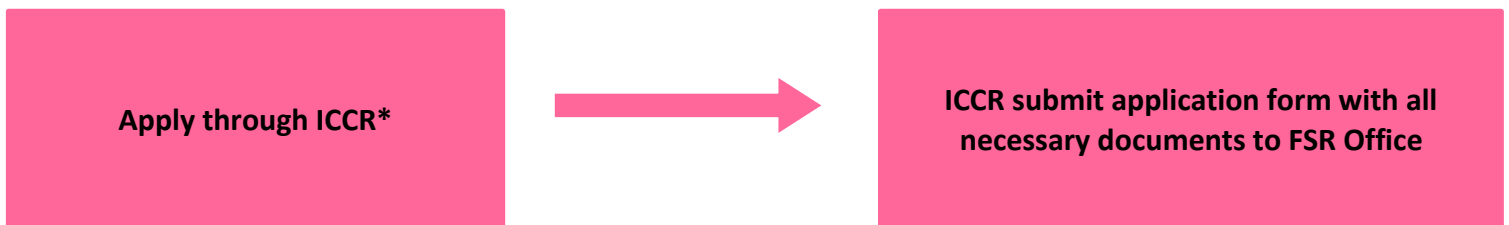
STEP 1: APPLY HOW TO APPLY?

(A): FOR SELF-FINANCING APPLICANTS (OTHER THAN GOVERNMENT-SPONSORED)



*Attestation should be done from the Embassy/ Indian Diplomatic Representative/ Ministry of Education of applicant's country in India.

(B): FOR ICCR AND GOVERNMENT-SPONSORED APPLICANTS



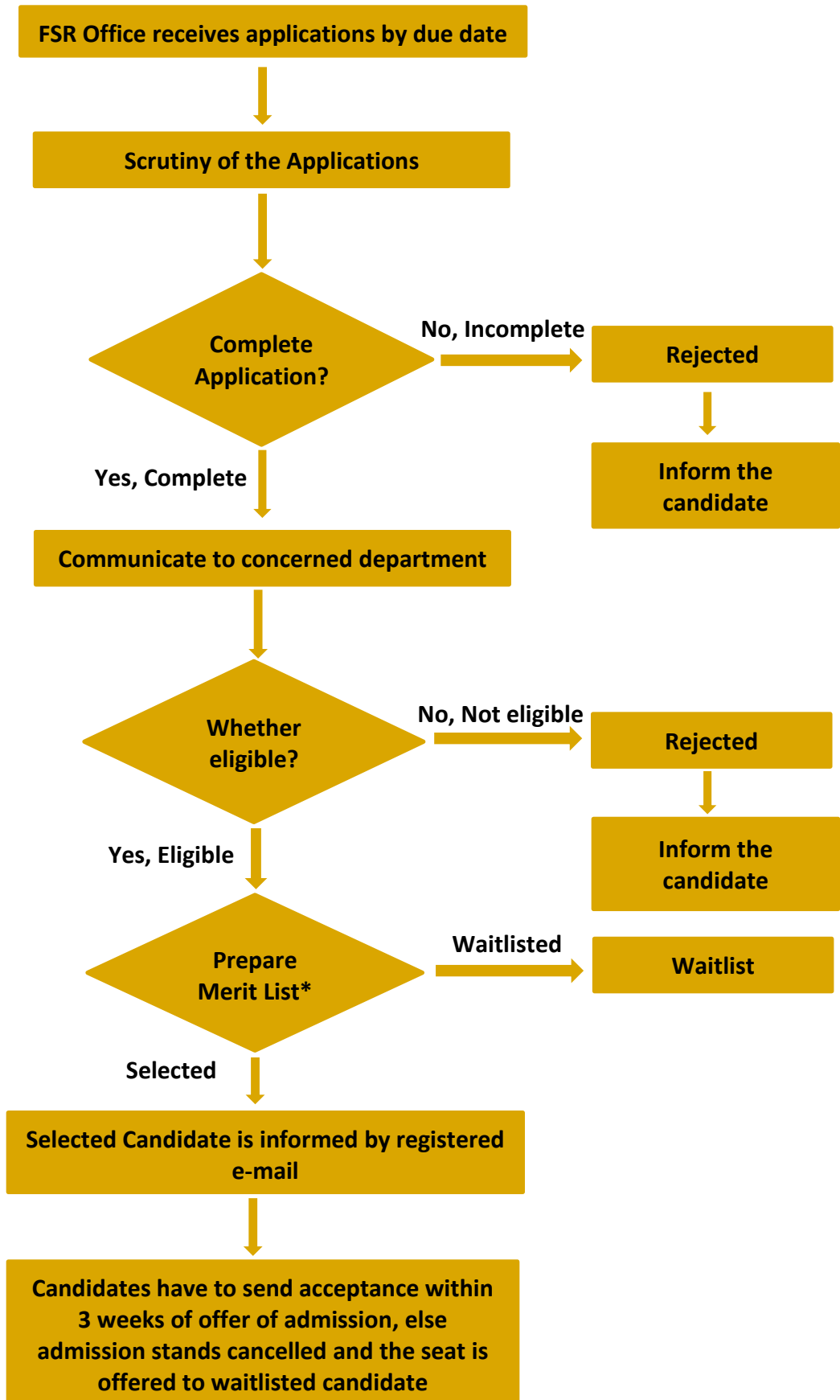
*Students applying to University of Delhi through ICCR may ensure that they have attached all the necessary documents listed in "Admission Guidelines" (page no.6) of FSR with the application form.

**Government-sponsored applicants should apply through Indian Council for Cultural Research (ICCR)

NOTE FOR ALL FOREIGN APPLICANTS (Self-Financing and ICCR Applicants):

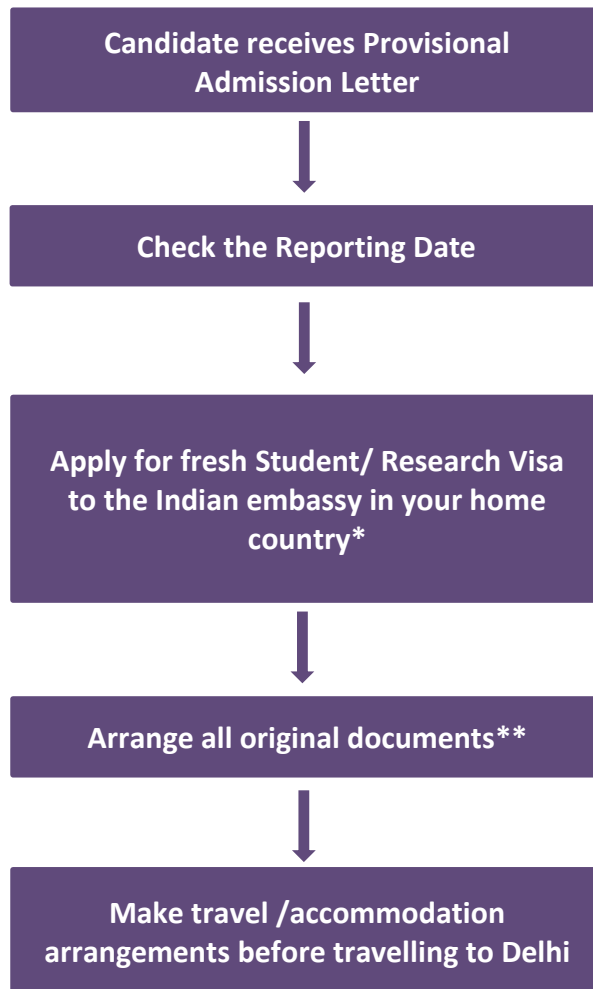
