
ADMISSION PROCEDURE FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS FOR THE ACADEMIC SESSION 2019-2020




STEP 1: APPLY HOW TO APPLY?

(A): FOR SELF-FINANCING APPLICANTS (OTHER THAN GOVERNMENT-SPONSORED)



^{*}Attestation should be done from the Embassy/ Indian Diplomatic Representative/ Ministry of Education of applicant's country in India.

(B): FOR ICCR AND GOVERNMENT-SPONSORED APPLICANTS



- **Government-sponsored applicants should apply through Indian Council for Cultural Research (ICCR)
